

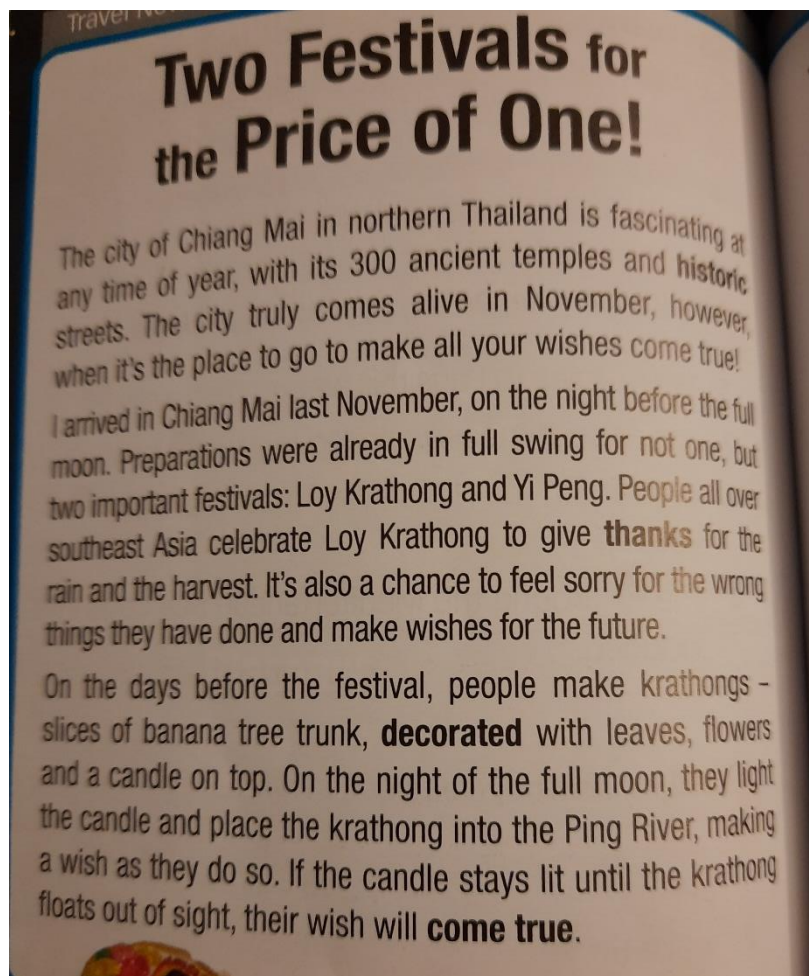

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
Topic: Two festivals for the Price of One! – reading practice.

People make or buy lanterns and then, at night, they light them and **release** them into the sky to welcome a bright future. In the same way as with the krathong, if the lantern stays lit, whatever the person wished for will happen.

There are traditional music, theatre and dance performances during the festivals, a huge street parade and lots of delicious Thai food to eat. I enjoyed every minute of the celebrations, which happen after dark over three days, but my favourite moment was on the second night, the night of the full moon. I'll never forget standing on Nawarat Bridge, the Ping River below me, on fire with krathongs. Thousands of lanterns were floating above me and I stood, caught in the moment, as tourists and **locals** sent their wishes across the water and into the sky. Moments like these are what the traveller in me lives for – to really see the world, instead of just looking at it.
